SSCA 50+ Report 2017

The **ECB 1st XI** had a very disappointing season. After two wins in the first two matches against Kent and Bucks, hopes were high. However, four subsequent defeats in the remaining matches left the side well short of qualification for the knock-out stage.

The season was, again, blighted by availability issues which must be resolved if Surrey is to compete again at the National level. All Counties are measured by the strength of their ECB XI (1st XI); so this is the key area SSCA must focus on.

John Fry is stepping down after 4 years at the helm. The side will be led by Keith Fisher for 2018 and we wish him every success for the season.

It was another successful season for the **Home Counties 2nd XI** in an ever increasingly competitive league winning 6 of the 8 matches, finishing second and making the playoff Final against Middlesex, the surprise winners. In the final Surrey would surely have won at 126-0 after 25 overs chasing 228 to win but rain intervened and calculators decided that Middlesex were the overall winners.

Some new players joined this year, notably Richard Greatorex, Mo Dilshad, Ian Barney and Gary Thomson who all produced the goods.

The bowling stats suggest that the side did not take enough wickets during the season to win the crucial moments in the close games.

Thank you to all who played, umpired, and especially the scorer John Lewis who moves to the 1st XI for 2018 as John Smith is retiring.

The **Southern Counties Championship XI** season proved to be most enjoyable, despite just failing to qualify for the knock out stage of the Championship. 27 players turned out for the team during the 10 league games and thanks go to all of them for giving great support throughout.

The squad included a number of new SSCA players alongside some long-standing team members and this mix worked well.

Many thanks to the umpires and scorers for their support during the campaign and as always thanks to Brian Aspital for all of his support and hard work. Finally, a special thanks to Robbie Burns who retired as scorer.

SSCA 60+/70+ Report 2017

The 2017 season was again blighted by the weather with 16 fixtures rained off. There were a total of 87 matches arranged, including friendlies, across the 5 sides, a remarkable achievement. As far as results were concerned they were mixed although some successes were seen.

The **1st XI**, led by Dave Debidin, was hopeful of a strong year but, disappointingly, the results did not bear this out, winning only 4 games out of 10. Several games were close and winning positions were established but not always taken advantage of. However, plans for next year will, hopefully, include a change of fortune for the team.

The **2nd XI**, with Graeme Howgate again at the helm, did not reach the

national play offs although they did win 5 games. This was a personal disappointment for Graeme. However, yet again, his encouragement of the team led them to perform very strongly and retain the Seevent Bowl trophy. The aim for next season will be a more consistent performance in the National league.

The **3rd XI**, captained shrewdly by Graham Ross, also had mixed results, finishing 3rd out of 5 in their league. Some good individual performances masked some inconsistency by the team although spirit was always positive. However, the side was much improved and should build on that next season.

The **4th XI** used 42 players across their 17 friendly games and this easily justified the continuation of this side. Rinaldo Frezzato led the team well and this was reflected in the 7 wins. Team spirit remained very high and this should continue throughout next season.

The **70+ XI** side won 9 out of 12 league games and came second in the league. This placed them in the play offs although a disappointing performance in the semi final against Worcestershire was a defeat to reflect upon. Roger Maynard again captained the side although illness in the latter part of the campaign allowed Steve Wells to display his captaincy skills.

A very successful tour to Holland was enjoyed by all.

Thanks must go to all captains and players, including umpires and scorers, for making 2017 such an enjoyable year. Special thanks also to Bill Early for arranging (and rearranging) all 87 games with the minimum of fuss.

SSCA Golf Report 2017
